

The Intelligent Choir

This 2-year project explores, innovates and consolidates modern methodology for both conductors and their singers. The methodology can be applied at any artistic level and by anyone who wishes to develop their skills within pop, rock and jazz.

“The Intelligent Choir” is the opposite of an unprepared choir. The purpose of this method is to educate and empower all singers and the result is a great musical and social cohesiveness in the choir.

The method is based on empirical research from experiences with amateurs as well as professional vocal ensembles and performers like The Real Group (S) and Bobby McFerrin (US). The daily work with students and trainees from Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Faroe Islands, Finland, Iceland, Germany, Austria, Holland, France and Poland has consolidated the method.

Working with choirs such as VoxNorth (DK) and the Danish National Girls Choir has proven the methodology to be efficient and the exercises create measurable results immediately.

During the next two years, the method will be demonstrated on various target groups by video samples. The method will be available for online courses with the purpose to welcome long-distance-learning students from all over the World.

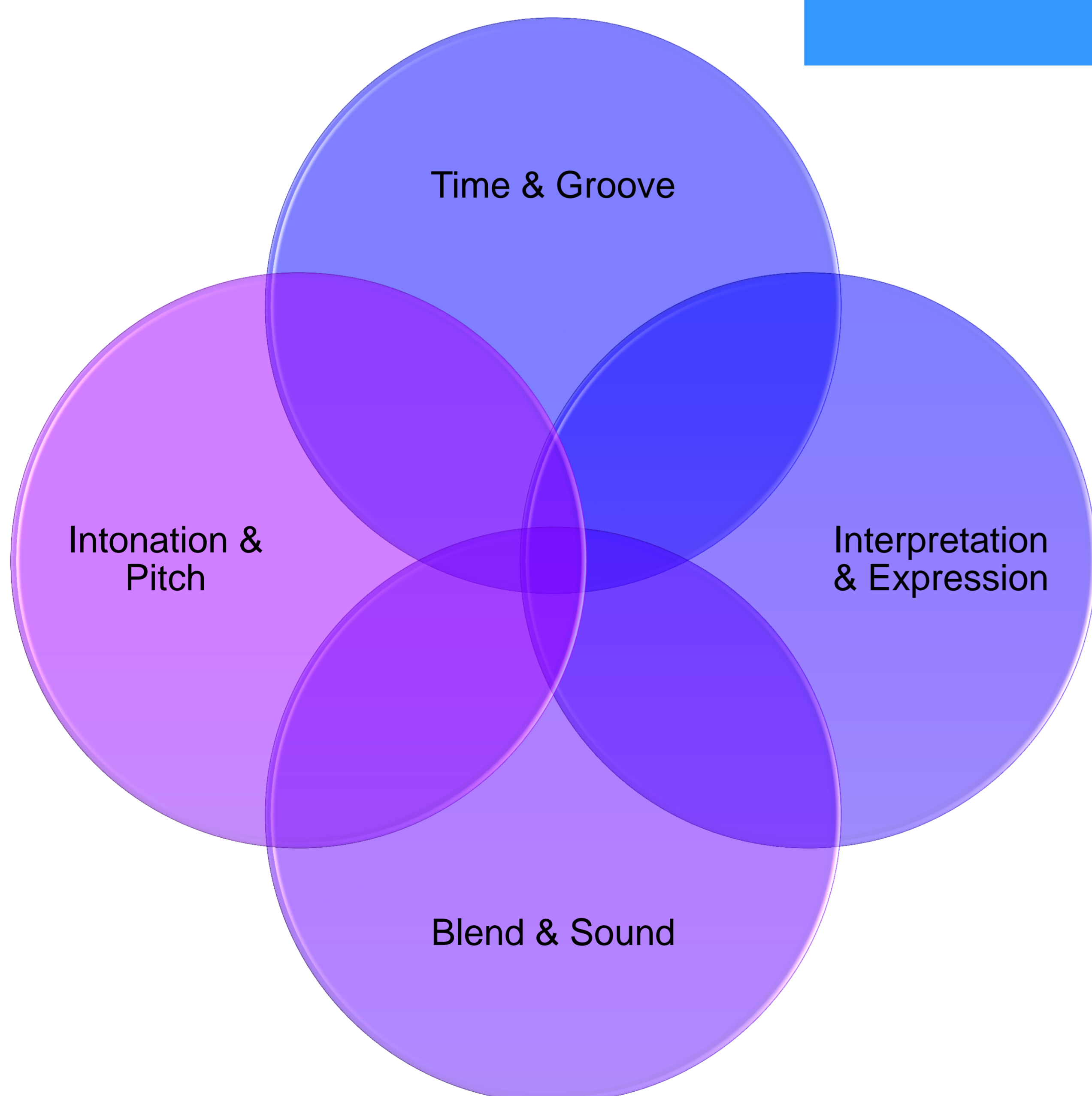
